

Willing to wait 100 years for your whisky?

The future owner of a 100-year-old bottle of whisky to be sold at a wine auction benefiting charity next week probably won't get the chance to ever taste the liquor.

Peter Gordon, chairman of Glenfiddich, will be donating a 100-year-old whisky to Willow Park's annual Charity Wine Auction, which benefits MCF Housing and helps build affordable seniors housing in Calgary.

The catch is that the buyer won't be able to collect the whisky for a century, as the bottle will be part of a series from a special cask developed by Canadian artist Dave Dyment at the Glenfiddich distillery this year.
